# ELIZA REDMANN

The works of Durham-based sculptural artist Eliza Redmann are uniquely informed by a car crash and traumatic brain injury which interrupted her career as an architectural designer. Redmann has used art to reinvent herself and create new meaning for her life.

Simplicity is both the constraint and the strength of Eliza Redmann's brand, Folded Poetry. The bedrock of Folded Poetry is the use of a small number of simple forms which can be arranged to create complex geometries. These geometries are inspired by persistent visual disturbances caused by her traumatic brain injury and challenge the viewer to perceive outside of what is normal or traditional, just as she must now live, adapt, and navigate the world in new ways.

Drawing upon her architectural training and skills in craft and construction, Redmann has brought her work to a large scale through the creation of dynamic sculptures. She has pioneered creations of 'acoustical art' pieces - works which are both beautiful and serve to make spaces more quiet and accessible for individuals such as herself who struggle with auditory overwhelm. Committed to exploration, Redmann's work pushes beyond framed pieces of art and navigates where aesthetics meet functionality.

#### PUBLIC ART

Stitching Stories Prison Awareness Quilt Reimagined, Co-Lead Artist April 2025 | Durham, NC | \$325k

This project entails working directly with incarcerated and formerly incarcerated women to design a permanent, durable, and long-lasting representation of the Prison Awareness Quilt which was crocheted by incarcerated women during the pandemic lockdown. The exhibit will be housed in a shipping container which will travel across North Carolina and beyond for public viewing to raise awareness for incarcerated persons. This project is funded by the Z. Smith Reynolds Foundation in partnership with The Andrew W. Mellon Foundation as part of their Inclusive Public Art Initiative which focuses on the transformative power of art for underrepresented narratives and communities.

The Journey | Installation: March 2024 | Denver, CO | \$50k Private Commission - 24ftx6ft sculptural art installation

Inspired by a journey to Pike's Peak, Colorado, this relief-sculpture dances around an L-shaped wall depicting compression and release using elements of nature; bark morphing into mountainscape. The piece will occupy the main lobby space in a new coworking building in Denver, CO and is scheduled for installation in early 2024.
